Overview

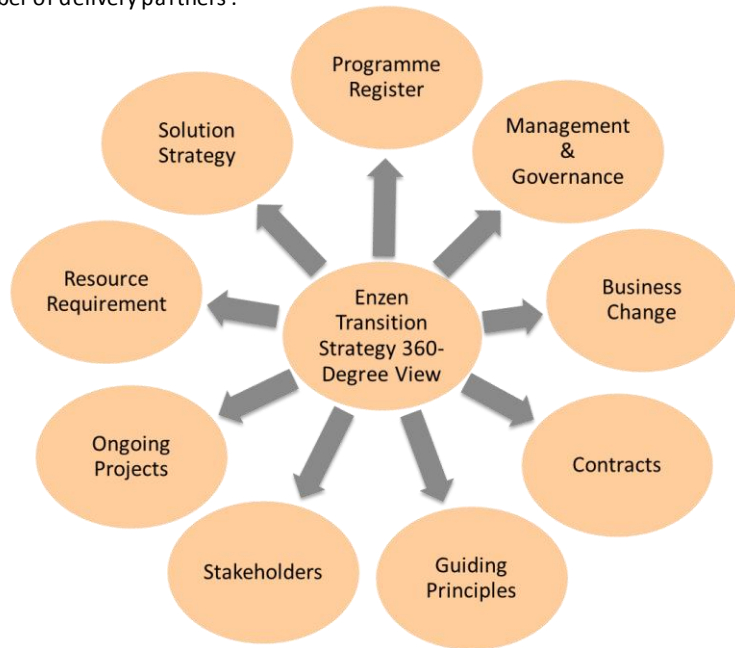
Enzen was engaged by UK's largest power distribution network as their prime IT partner and systems integrator to deliver complex IT systems as part of a major IT Separation programme

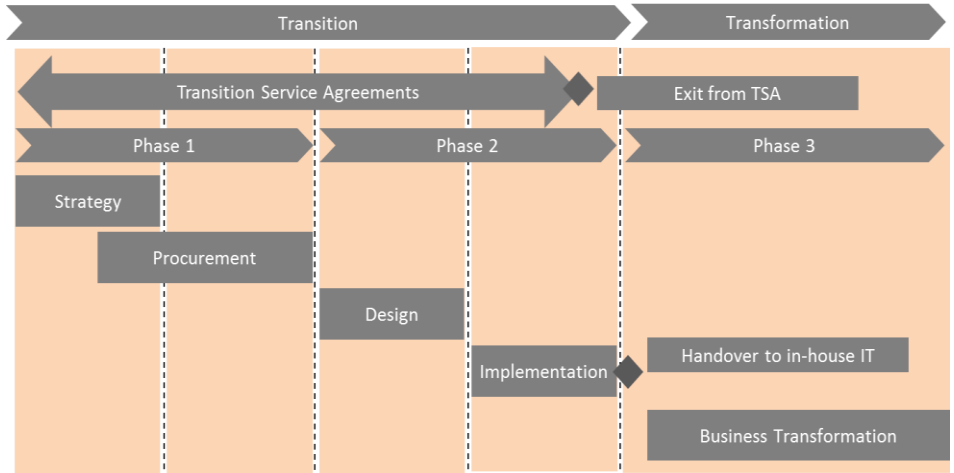
IT Transition Road Map

A representative transition roadmap leading to transformation consisting of the key phases of work

Phase 1 : Defining the overall Transition , Exit Strategy including capturing the key risks , dependencies and assumptions. This phase also involves managing the procurement process for the executing the transition programme

Phase 2 : Putting together the overall transition design and managing the end to end implementation leading to exit from the TSA

Phase 3 : Plan and initiate Business Transformation initiatives in order of Business priority and benefits case
